Inconsiderate Parking

It has been brought to our attention that some parents have been parking in very inconsiderate and unsafe places. We have been given the following details of cars parked in this way and are as follows:

- A silver Renault, registration number **YD07 UAR** was parked across a driveway on Apsley Road yesterday, causing the resident to be late collecting their own child from school.
- Also, a brown Honda, registration number **VN55 DLW** has been seen parked on the yellow zig-zag lines on more than one occasion.

We would be very grateful if parents would respect our neighbours and the safety of our children when parking near and entering school. We do advise residents to contact the police when they cannot access their property.

We have also had a number of complaints regarding the pedestrian crossing situated on the driveway in to school. May we remind you that pedestrians will be using the crossing so it is advisable to adhere to the 5mph speed limit and stop at the crossing as necessary.
