Theme

Supporting your child's learning

In Maths ensuring children can confidently recall all multiplication and division facts (up to twelve) is key for many aspects of the curriculum.

Ensuring that your child is reading frequently is invaluable. Listening to them read and asking questions linked to the text is also important to help improve their understanding.

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Homework

Children receive homework every week. Homework consists of English and maths tasks, online Abacus games, spellings and reading. Homework is handed out on Fridays and due back on the following dates:

Monday - English task

Tuesday - Abacus games (if there is still a game showing on your screen, it won't show as completed on mine).

Wednesday - Spellings (books to be checked to ensure children are practising. Spellings are then tested and given out on Thursdays.

Thursday - Maths task

We are happy to help with any homework if needed, however, children need to be proactive and ask before the deadline.

Things to remember

PE kits need to be in school on Wednesday and Friday. If your child has their ears pierced, earrings need to be removed on these days unless they can do it by themselves.
