Supporting your child's learning

Children frequently have opportunities to change their home reading book; remembering to do so is their responsibility.

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Homework

Children receive homework every week. Homework consists of English and maths tasks, online Abacus games, spellings and reading. Homework is handed out on Fridays and due back on the following dates:

Wednesday - Spellings

Thursday - Maths

Things to remember
